

DOs

- 1. **Follow legal guidelines:** Ensure you comply with local, state, and federal regulations regarding the use of Alphachloralose. Obtain necessary permits and follow all legal requirements.
- 2. **Pre-baiting:** Before introducing Alphachloralose Coated Mung Beans, it's recommended to pre-bait the area with untreated mung beans for several days. This acclimates pigeons to the feeding location, making them more likely to consume the treated beans later.

DON'Ts

- 2. **Do not ignore non-target species:** Minimise exposure to other animals. Remove unconsumed bait promptly and clean areas of deployment. Use on flat surfaces that will facilitate cleaning as opposed to feeding on grass.
- 3. **Do not leave bait unattended:** Alphachloralose bait should never be left unattended. Check and remove unconsumed bait to prevent accidental ingestion by non-target species.
- 4. **Do not neglect safety precautions:** Do not ignore safety precautions when handling Alphachloralose. Wear appropriate protective gear and follow all safety guidelines to avoid accidental exposure. Wash your hands after handling.
