Trapping tips and tricks.

Trap Setup

If using T-posts instead of trees, be sure they are 6.5 to 7 ft. Shorter posts will not work. Test ground anchors by pulling aggressively. They should stay firmly seated when pulled.

Conditioning Mode

Initially, spread bait inside and outside the trap. Get the pigs used to feeling the raised net (12–15 in off the ground) on their backs. Don't shoot at them, run dogs in the areas or feed them anywhere else.


Capture Mode

Make sure the hooked cam straps are super tight and all the corn is in the center of the trap. If the site is muddy, toss straw or hay wherever the net will touch the ground.

Removal

Approach the trap calmly and let the pigs tire themselves out before euthanizing or trailering for relocation.

How Pig Brig Traps Catch Pigs.




Set Up the Trap

Using T-posts or trees, build the trap where you see signs of pig activity.

Bait Your Site

Put your bait out and get the pigs comfortable feeding under the raised net.



Set Your Trap


Lower the net to the ground. The pigs will root inside but not be able to root back out.

The design is as ingenious as its components are simple. Sturdy netting that stands up to even the biggest, most aggressive boars, along with heavy duty hardware to hold it all together make up our efficient, effective, all-in-one patented trap.

What's included?

Base Net

A 20-ft diameter base net with a dynamic drop strength of more than 8,000-ft-lbs as well as a vinyl-coated easy pull cable seam that makes opening and closing your trap a piece of cake.

Boar Shield


A heavy-duty, double wall of net that keeps big boars inside.

Hardware Kit

This kit includes everything you need to set the net: 2-ft ground anchors, ground anchor driver, anchor stakes, double-hooked cam straps, T-post mounts and zip ties. T-posts are not included. If you use trees, you may not need them.

Trap Cap (Optional)

A 2-ft-wide trap cap—that can be clipped or sewn in—covers approximately 30% of the net opening, keeping jumpers where they belong: inside the trap.





When we were forced to take "no" for an answer, something magical happened.







For all of the incredible things the Pig Brig Trap can do, its development came about largely because of the things we couldn't do. Or, more specifically, weren't allowed to do.

Working on a feral hog eradication project on the Pacific Island of Guam, our biologists were forbidden from driving posts into the ground or any work that would disrupt the soil due to unexploded WWII ordnance.

It was these restrictions that resulted in the Pig Brig's breakthrough design.

When we started hanging nets from trees, we realized that, thanks to the pigs' natural rooting behavior, the animals would continuously enter the trap unimpeded. And by not relying on a remotely triggered gate, our catch numbers were much higher than they had been with traditional metal traps.

Just like that, Pig Brig Trap Systems was born: a simpler, smarter, more effective way to trap feral pigs. And we continue to push the design, features and functionality of the Pig Brig Trap, learning from our customers and delivering new products and new solutions.

What kind of warranty do you offer?

For all valid warranty claims, we will either repair or replace the defect. If we can't do either of those, we'll be happy to offer a full refund.

How many people does it take to set it up?

Where can I use it?
